Help preserve a unique environment!

Lake Hornborga, is a place of natural beauty and biological diversity. As a visitor, you have the privilege of experiencing all of this, but you must also treat the environment with care. By following our code of conduct, you help preserve this unique environment.

Respect nature and wildlife The Lake Hornborga region is home to a vast number of plants and wild animals. Help preserve this by not picking flowers, disturbing wildlife or littering. Mind the birds in particular.



Inside the nature reserve, special rules apply. At hornborga.com/nature/rules/ you can read what applies in which area.

Follow the Right of Public Access Outside the nature reserve, the Right of Public Access applies. Please be aware that it also comes with obligations. Do not cross gardens, crops or other land that you might damage. Also, remember to close gates behind you when walking through pastures.



Shop local By shopping at markets, shops and restaurants/cafes that are owned or run by locals, you support the local community, while also making your stay more memorable.

Use parking spaces Please park your camper van in a dedicated space. This helps support the local economy, while also preserving the environment and having a pleasant stay.

Be responsible for your dog In spring and summer, you are required by law to watch your dog closely. In most cases, this means that it must be leashed. Inside the nature reserve, dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Avoid walking your dog in paddocks with grazing animals.

Protect our cultural heritage Resist the temptation to collect "travel souvenirs". By leaving the site intact, you help preserve Lake Hornborga's historical and cultural treasures for the future.

Keep tidy Leave no trace behind. Pick up rubbish and waste – even things left behind by others. By doing the right thing, you inspire others to do the same.



Waste separation Please separate your waste, even as a visitor. Find the nearest recycling station or take your rubbish home with you.



Never throw away food scraps outdoors Swine fever is a dangerous disease that affects wild boars and domestic pigs. It can be transmitted when wild boar eat things such as sausage or ham. This is why you should never throw away food scraps outdoors.

Save water Water is an important resource – use it sparingly. Never empty greywater or latrine waste into the environment.

Drive carefully Pay attention to speed limits and traffic rules, especially on narrow roads. Where possible, use larger roads.

Fill up on eco-friendly fuel Consider using HVO100 if suitable for your camper van. The emission reduction is almost 90 percent compared to fossil diesel.

Be considerate of others Show consideration for locals and other visitors. It helps create an enjoyable experience for everyone. Take care of the place as if you lived here yourself.

Support local projects Please consider supporting local conservation projects. These help to preserve the natural beauty and diversity of Lake Hornborga.
